- REPORTING.—The Secretary of Defense shall instruct the

Secretary of each military department to undertake a comprehensive review of the department's policies and procedures for reporting members of the Armed Forces absent 3 without leave, on unauthorized absence, or missing. 5 OFInstallation-level REVIEW 6 DURES.—The head of each military installation command 7 shall— 8 (1) direct each military installation under its 9 command to review its policies and procedures for 10 carrying out the reporting activities described under 11 subsection (a); and 12 (2) update such installation-level policies and 13 procedures with a view towards force protection, en-14 hanced security for members of the Armed Forces 15 living on base, and prioritizing reporting at the ear-16 liest reasonable time to local law enforcement at all 17 levels, and Federal law enforcement field offices with 18 overlapping jurisdiction with that installation, when 19 a member is determined to be missing. 20 REPORTING Installation-specific Proto-21 COLS.— 22 (1) IN GENERAL.—The commander of each 23 military installation shall establish a protocol for 24 sharing information with local and Federal law en-25 forcement agencies about members of the Armed

1 Forces that are absent without leave, on unauthor-2 ized absence, or missing. The protocol shall provide, 3 by memorandum of understanding or otherwise, for the commander to immediately notify all local and 4 5 Federal law enforcement agencies with jurisdictions 6 in the immediate area of the military installation 7 when the status of a member assigned to such in-8 stallation has been changed to absent without leave, 9 on unauthorized absence, or missing. 10 (2) Reporting to military installation 11 COMMAND.—The commander of each military installation shall submit the protocol established pursuant 12 13 to paragraph (1) to the relevant military installation
