3 SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF PILOT PROGRAM ON ACCEPT4 ANCE BY THE DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS
5 AFFAIRS OF DONATED FACILITIES AND RE6 LATED IMPROVEMENTS.
7 Section 2 of the CHIP IN for Vets Act of 2016 (Pub8 lic Law 114–294; 38 U.S.C. 8103 note) is amended—

1	(1) in subsection (i), by striking "the date that
2	is 5 years after the date of the enactment of this
3	Act" and inserting "December 31, 2026"; and
4	(2) by adding at the end the following new sub-

6	"(k) Report.—Not later than December 31, 2021,
7	the Secretary shall submit to the Committees on Veterans'
