1	SECTION 1. REPORTS ON PILOT PROGRAM ON ACCEPT-
2	ANCE BY THE DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS
3	AFFAIRS OF DONATED FACILITIES AND RE-
4	LATED IMPROVEMENTS.
5	Section 2 of the CHIP IN for Vets Act of 2016 (Pub-
6	lic Law 114–294; 38 U.S.C. 8103 note) is amended by
7	adding at the end the following new subsection:
8	"(k) Reports.—Not later than 90 days after the
9	date of the enactment of this subsection, and not later
10	than December 31 of each year thereafter during the life
11	of the pilot program, the Secretary shall submit to the
12	Committees on Veterans' Affairs of the House of Rep-
13	resentatives and the Senate a report on the pilot program.
14	The report shall include, as of the date of the report, the
15	following:
16	"(1) Identification of the real property and im-
17	provements donated under the pilot program that
18	have been successfully completed.
19	"(2) Identification of the donation agreements
20	that have been entered into under the pilot program
21	that are still in progress or under consideration.
22	"(3) Of the donation agreements identified
23	under paragraph (2), a list of such agreements or-
24	dered by the priority of the Secretary, including jus-
25	tifications for such prioritization.

1	"(4) Identification of the proposed donation
2	agreements that the Secretary has not entered into
3	under the pilot program, including a detailed de-
4	scription of the justifications for not entering into
5	the agreements.".
