
Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro,

I am requesting funding for the City of Canyon Emergency Power Resiliency Project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Canyon, located at 301 16th Street, Canyon, Texas 79015. The funding would be used to purchase and install emergency power generation at key municipal facilities in the City of Canyon, including the city hall, fire station, community emergency center, public works and solid waste facility, sewer treatment plant, and water barn.
