

To provide that under the securities laws certain disclosures related to scope 3 greenhouse-gas emissions may not be required.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the "Scope 3 Act".

5 **SEC. 2. SCOPE 3 GREENHOUSE-GAS EMISSIONS DISCLO-**
6 **SURES.**

7 Under the securities laws (as such term is defined
8 in section 3(a)(47) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934

1 (15 U.S.C. 78c)), an issuer may not be required to disclose
2 or otherwise provide information with respect to the green-
3 house-gas emissions or consumption of the value chain of
4 such issuer (commonly known as “Scope 3 emissions”).
