As members of the Texas delegation, we write to underscore our support for the House-passed budget resolution so Congress and the administration can address the critical and urgent need to support our troops, strengthen our food supply, and secure our elections.

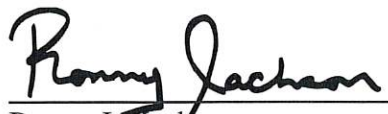
Our brave soldiers, sailors, airmen, and marines are protecting American lives by preventing Iran from obtaining a nuclear weapon. Congress must provide them with the supplemental munitions they need to finish the job and come home safely. We support you, our Commander in Chief, Secretary of War Pete Hegseth, and our brave men and women in uniform. Unfortunately, we will get no help from our Democrat colleagues who continue an unprecedented posture of obstruction. Therefore, we urge the Senate to provide the requested \$67 billion in supplemental defense funds through reconciliation immediately.

Texas' farmers and ranchers work tirelessly to feed and clothe our nation and much of the world. After four years of economic hardship and rising input costs due to President Biden's fiscal failures, Congress must provide temporary emergency assistance to the producers who grow, raise, and deliver our food.
