I am requesting funding for the Runaway Bay Wastewater Infrastructure Project in Fiscal Year 2026. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Runaway Bay, located at 101 Runaway Bay Drive Runaway Bay, Texas 76426. The funding would be used to complete 7 emergency projects—including two gravity main replacements, lift station rehabilitation and expansion, water/wastewater treatment plant improvements, sewer system testing, manhole replacements, and SCADA system upgrades. This project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds, because it will greatly help the city prevent untreated wastewater from flowing into Lake Bridgeport and reduce the exposure and health risks associated with contaminated drinking water.
