3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
4 This Act may be cited as the "Foreign Animal Dis-
5 ease Prevention, Surveillance, and Rapid Response Act of
6 2025".

1	SEC. 2. REAUTHORIZATION OF ANIMAL DISEASE PREVEN-
2	TIONS AND MANAGEMENT PROGRAMS.
3	(a) Mandatory Funding.—Section 10409A(d)(1)
4	of the Animal Health Protection Act (7 U.S.C.
5	8308a(d)(1)) is amended to read as follows:
6	"(1) Mandatory funding.—
7	"(A) FISCAL YEARS 2023 THROUGH 2025.—
8	Of the funds of the Commodity Credit Corpora-
9	tion, the Secretary shall make available to carry
10	out this section \$30,000,000 for each of fiscal
11	years 2023 through 2025, of which not less
12	than \$18,000,000 shall be made available for
13	each of those fiscal years to carry out sub-
14	section (b).
15	"(B) FISCAL YEARS 2026 THROUGH 2030.—
16	Of the funds of the Commodity Credit Corpora-
17	tion, the Secretary shall make available to carry
18	out this section \$233,000,000 for each of fiscal
19	years 2026 through 2030, of which—
20	"(i) not less than \$10,000,000 shall
21	be made available for each such fiscal year
22	to carry out subsection (a);
23	"(ii) not less than \$70,000,000 shall
24	be made available for each such fiscal year
25	to carry out subsection (b); and

1	"(iii) not less than \$153,000,000 shall
2	be made available for each such fiscal year
3	to carry out subsection (c).
4	"(C) Subsequent fiscal years.—Of the
5	funds of the Commodity Credit Corporation, the
6	Secretary shall make available to carry out this
7	section \$75,000,000 for fiscal year 2031 and
8	each fiscal year thereafter, of which not less
9	than \$45,000,000 shall be made available for
10	each of those fiscal years to carry out sub-
11	section (b).".
