A BILL

To eliminate taxpayer funding for the partisan radio outlet known as National Public Radio, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “No Partisan Radio
5 Act” or the “NPR Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON FEDERAL FUNDING FOR NA-**
7 **TIONAL PUBLIC RADIO.**

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—After the date of the enactment
9 of this Act, no Federal funds may, directly or indirectly,

1 be made available to or used to support the organization
2 described in subsection (b), including through the payment
3 of dues to or the purchase of programming from such or-
4 ganization by a public broadcast station using Federal
5 funds received by such station.

6 (b) ORGANIZATION DESCRIBED.—The organization
7 described in this subsection is—

8 (1) the organization known, as of the date of
9 the enactment of this Act, as “National Public
10 Radio”; or

11 (2) any successor organization to the organiza-
12 tion described in paragraph (1).
