6 (a) PROHIBITION.—No Federal funds may be used
7 by the Secretary of Homeland Security to implement or
8 enforce a remain in Texas policy.

- 1 (b) Remain in Texas Policy Defined.—In this
- 2 section, the term "remain in Texas policy" means a policy
- 3 that requires any alien to remain in the State of Texas
- 4 after such alien is released or paroled by the Secretary
- 5 of Homeland Security or the Secretary of Health and
- 6 Human Services into the United States, including requir-
- 7 ing the use of GPS monitoring devices to track the loca-
- 8 tion of the alien.
