**A BILL**

To eliminate taxpayer funding for the partisan broadcasting outlets known as National Public Radio and the Public Broadcasting Service, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “No Partisan Radio  
5 and Partisan Broadcasting Services Act” or the “NPR  
6 and PBS Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON FEDERAL FUNDING FOR NA-**  
2 **TIONAL PUBLIC RADIO AND PUBLIC BROAD-**  
3 **CASTING SERVICE.**

4 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—After the date of the enactment  
5 of this Act, no Federal funds may, directly or indirectly,  
6 be made available to or used to support an organization  
7 described in subsection (b), including through the payment  
8 of dues to or the purchase of programming from such or-  
9 ganization by a public broadcast station using Federal  
10 funds received by such station.

11 (b) **ORGANIZATIONS DESCRIBED.**—The organizations  
12 described in this subsection are—

13 (1) the organization known, as of the date of  
14 the enactment of this Act, as “National Public  
15 Radio”;

16 (2) the organization known, as of the date of  
17 the enactment of this Act, as the “Public Broad-  
18 casting Service”; and

19 (3) any successor organization to an organiza-  
20 tion described in paragraph (1) or (2).
