I am requesting funding for the Runaway Bay Wastewater Infrastructure Project in fiscal year 2025. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Runaway Bay, located at 101 Runaway Bay Drive Runaway Bay, Texas 76426. The funding would be used to complete 7 emergency projects—including two gravity main replacements, lift station rehabilitation and expansion, water/wastewater treatment plant improvements, sewer system testing, manhole replacements, and SCADA system upgrades.
